The official DECA emblem is a diamond-shaped design. It embraces the organization's affinity for the diamond while displaying a bold, modern design.

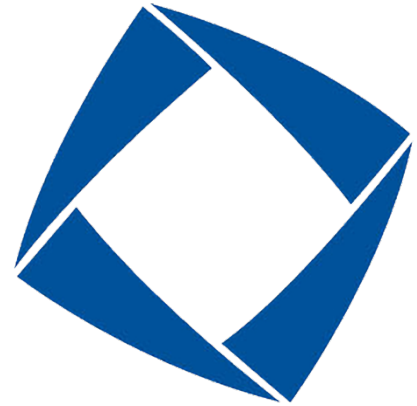

DECA Inc. Establishment

DECA was established nationally in 1946 with 17 charter states. The first interstate DECA conference was held in Memphis, TN, April 1947.

PA DECA Establishment

PA DECA was first organized in 1952, but Pennsylvania did not receive an official charter from DECA Inc. until 1960.

Geography

- DECA operates in all 50 states plus Puerto Rico, Guam, Canada, China, Spain, South Korea and Germany.
- Pennsylvania is located in the North Atlantic Region of DECA Inc.
- Pennsylvania DECA is divided into 11 districts

PA DECA Board of Trustees

This is the official governing body of Pennsylvania DECA.

PA DECA Plan of Action

The Plan of Action is developed by the State Officer Team each year to set goals for chapters to accomplish and to recognize the most active PA DECA chapters.

DECA Terminology

- DECA offers a well-rounded "competitive events program", not "contests".
- At the local level, DECA is referred to as a "chapter", not a "club".
- Persons belonging to a DECA chapter are "members", not "DECA students".
- DECA Inc. is made up of state and territorial "chartered associations". Chartered associations are made up of local chapters.
- CTSO is an acronym for Career and Technical Student Organization
- "DECA" is not an acronym, as it no longer stands for Distributive Education Clubs of America.
